Registration: **PRIOR** to 8.00am - Briefing: 8.15am - Play: 8.30am (both days)

NB 1 - teams are expected to wear a coordinated uniform throughout the tournament.

NB 2 - The entry procedures, player code of conduct and FIPJP rules are all on the PNZ website, please ensure you have read all documents prior to entering.

1. Tournament Eligibility (see entry procedures)

2. Format

Friday

- Preliminary rounds shooting competition – 2.00pm – 6.00pm (NB must be registered to compete)
- Executive Forum at 6.00pm in the clubrooms (later than usual due to pointing and shooting)

Saturday

- All teams will play 5 Swiss ladder games timed at 1hr + 1 end and one further end if the result is drawn.
- Preliminary rounds of shooting competition - 4.00pm to 6.00pm

Sunday

- All teams will play 2 further Swiss ladder games timed at 1 hr + 1 end and one further end if the result is drawn, then ranked on number of wins and Buchholz and Fine Buchholz Numbers as the tie break system. **(See website for Buchholz explanation).**
- At completion of the Swiss seeding rounds there will be a single elimination format. The top 8 will play for the Trophy; second 8 for Trophy Consolation, the remaining teams will play for Plate, Plate Consolation, Bowl, Bowl Consolation, depending on the number of entries. Timing of elimination rounds will depend on entries and time available.
- Final of shooting and pointing competitions between the seeding rounds and elimination rounds. (top 2 qualifiers)
- PNZ reserves the right to change the format depending on the number of entries.

3. Tournament rules

- The tournament will be played to the current FIPJP Rules (1 January 17) and any interpretations specific to NZ as adopted by PNZ (1 January 2019). All participants should be familiar with these rules prior to entering.
- Entrants are required to participate in the entire tournament; i.e. a player/team cannot leave partway through without good cause.
- Immediately at the conclusion of each game a member from **both** teams is required to sign that the score is correct on the result sheet. No score will be entered until both teams are present.

4. Catering

Tea, coffee and water will be available throughout the tournament. Lunch will be available to purchase and there will be a dinner on the Saturday evening at 6.30pm at the local Mornington Tavern – see Dunedin City information sheet for further information.
