Petanque is a target sport, where participants throw metal balls as close as possible to a small wooden ball called a jack, while standing inside a circle with both feet on the ground.

Petanque rules are simple, learned within minutes, it is a low tech and inexpensive requiring no major equipment or clothing. It is social, fun and a great challenge. It is possibly the only sport that can be played competitively by any age group from 5 -95 and is suitable for players with a range of abilities; you don't have to be fast, fit or strong. Individuals can choose to play purely for social fun or can go on to achieve National and even International recognition if they put the time and energy into the sport.
