



PNZ's policy around funding NZ teams and uniforms was reviewed and refined at the March 2017 Board meeting.

Financial assistance

As a small amateur sport, PNZ is not (at this time) in a position to fund expenses for NZ representative teams, however we do acknowledge the huge commitment and expense associated with representing NZ, and that those playing at the highest level have the greatest expense.

PNZ's new policy is designed to give the greatest support to those playing at the highest level and will contribute \$200 to each player selected to a NZ team attending a world championship.

Uniform – Players

The new uniform policy provides one generic uniform for all PNZ teams. These will have the PNZ logo, but not tournament information so they can be used for all International events a player is selected for. No variations of the uniform are allowed. If players require wet weather gear or a warm layer under their top, these should be in plain black only.

PNZ supply a full uniform on your 1st year of Representation - 2 polo shirts, 1 tracksuit top, 1 pair of trousers (or \$50.00 towards trousers) and 1 cap

All other uniform items or replacement items must be purchased at the players expense

After 5 years of representation – replacement items may be provided if required

Uniform – Coaches

No variations of the uniform are allowed. If players require wet weather gear or a warm layer under their top, these should be in plain black only.

PNZ supply a full uniform on a one-off basis to coaches - 2 polo shirts (marked coach), 1 tracksuit top, 1 pair of trousers (or \$50.00 towards trousers) and 1 cap

All other uniform items or replacement items must be purchase at the coach's expense.

PLEASE NOTE – Your PNZ playing uniform should be worn travelling to and from, or playing in, an International Event where you are representing NZ. It should not be worn at any other time or for casual use.
