

**PNZ advises that it will keep records of:**

- Infringements of the rules of petanque occurring during competitions, as per Umpire's reports.
- Infringements of the Rules of PNZ, including its Code of Conduct and, Tournament Entry procedures.
- Any other disciplinary matters brought to the attention of the Board.

Such registers will record the date and/or place of the offence/infringement, the name of the player concerned, and the penalty imposed.

Where a player is suspended from competition, or from membership of Petanque New Zealand, PNZ will advise all PNZ-affiliated Clubs and Regional Associations of the player's name and period of suspension.

PNZ reserves the right to make this information publicly available if it considers it to be in the interests of petanque in New Zealand.
